Nominations are now being accepted for the Annual Susan Barton Award. This prestigious award honours the enduring legacy of Susan Barton by recognizing her activist spirit, dedication to volunteerism, and steadfast commitment to workers' rights, equality, and social justice.

About the Award

The Women's Committee of the New Brunswick Council of Nursing Home Unions established this award to pay tribute to Susan Barton's extraordinary contributions. The award is presented each year to a past or present Sister of the New Brunswick Council of Nursing Home Unions who exemplifies the values Susan demonstrated throughout her life.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for the Annual Susan Barton Award, nominees must be Sisters whose actions reflect the following:

- Demonstrated a deep commitment to creating opportunities and fairness for all.
- Worked diligently to break down barriers and foster greater participation for women within the labour movement.
- Showed initiative and passion in advancing women's rights.
- Contributed to developing a stronger sense of community togetherness.

Nomination Process

CUPE locals affiliated with the New Brunswick Council of Nursing Home Unions are invited to nominate a Sister who meets the criteria above for this special recognition. Nominations should be submitted to the Women's Committee for the Susan Barton Award no later than February 1st.
